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Age of Exploration: Explorer Portfolio Project (MAJOR-ASSESSMENT GRADE)



The Age of Exploration was an important time in our history. Explorers risked their lives to learn more about the world, and our country wouldn't be the same today if it weren't for their discoveries. Your task is to design a portfolio that highlights several important aspects of the Age of Exploration. Your portfolio should be based on facts from researching this time period and vour explorer, and they should include the following criteria:

1. Biographical Paragraph

Write a one-paragraph (minimum 7 sentences) summary that includes:

- Answers to the 5 "W" questions (who, what, when, where, why)
- Motives for voyage
- Impacts/Accomplishments of voyage

2. First-Person Journal Entry

Using the same explorer as your biographical paragraph, write a creative one-paragraph (minimum 7 sentences) journal entry that includes:

- Historically accurate date of your journey
- Observations of your new findings or environment (climate, resources, culture, landscape)
- Where you're headed or what you hope to find
- Reflection of your emotions at this point in your journey
- Include at least two historically accurate pieces of information

3. Expedition Map

Create a hand-drawn map with the route drawn of the expeditions of your explorer. Your expedition map needs to have descriptive captions of the journey with at least 5 stops. Each caption should be 1-2 sentences in length and contain factual information about your explorer. A blank world map will be given to you, but you must draw in the route of your explorer.

4. Decorated Portfolio Cover

Design a portfolio cover that includes your explorer name, basic biographical facts (where/when they were born, death year, family information), and pictures/graphics about your explorer. Be creative and make your portfolio unique in remembering your explorer!
