# VOCABULARY CHOICE BOARD

Each week you will get 10 new words relating to one or two Greek roots. You will copy down your new words on the first day of the week and quiz on those words the first day of the next week. In the meantime, you will have 2 vocabulary homework assignments that you can also work on during warm-ups before they are due.

- Vocab homework will be due/collected every Wednesday and Friday for a homework check.
- The weekly quiz will be a minor grade.

**Choose 2 different vocabulary activities from the board below each week. You may repeat an activity you did last week, but you may not repeat activities in the same week.**

<p><b>Flashcards</b> Create flashcards that you can use to study your words. (This is a good one to do on the first night)</p>	<p><b>Story Time</b> Write a creative story using at least 7 vocabulary words correctly. Underline your vocabulary words, and give your story a title.</p>	<p><b>Draw It Out</b> Choose 7 words and illustrate them. Caption each drawing with the word, part of speech, and definition.</p>
<p><b>Investigate</b> Find 5 more words with that root and define them. How do they relate to the root?</p>	<p><b>Crossword Puzzle</b> Create a crossword puzzle online using all words and definitions.</p>	<p><b>Make It Up</b> Create 5 brand new words using the root of the week, and define your unique words (they should all have to do with your root)</p>
<p><b>Connect Two</b> Choose 3 sets of 2 words you think belong together, and state the reason for making the connection: <i>"I would connect ___ and ___ because ___."</i> <b>Your reason CANNOT be because they share the same root!</b></p>	<p><b>Greeting Card</b> Choose at least 2 words and design an illustrated greeting card (birthday, thank you, feel better etc) for a person of your choice. The words must be used correctly for full credit.</p>	<p><b>In Your Own Words</b> Write the definition of 7 vocabulary words in <u>your own student-friendly words</u>.</p>
