1. **circumspect** - (adjective) careful to look at all possibilities before acting; cautious; aware of consequences
2. **inspect** - (verb) to look at carefully in search of flaws
(noun form: inspection)
3. **introspection** - (noun) the act of looking into one's own thoughts and feelings
(adjective form: introspective)
4. **perspective** - (noun) one way of looking at things
5. **respect**- (verb) to look up to someone; to show honor
(can also be a noun)
(adjective form: respectful)
6. **retrospective**- (adjective) looking back at past things
7. **spectacle**- (noun) something displayed for the public to see
8. **spectacles**- (noun) glasses that help someone see better
9. **spectator**- (noun) a person who watches something, such as a sporting event
(verb form: spectate- to watch)
10. **speculate**- (verb) to look at and think about something from different points of view
